Piano Camp participants will receive one on one attention with lessons on solo repertoire as well as enjoy collaborative piano works with other participants. There will be master classes, sessions on positive public performance attitude, improvisation, and other topics to develop a complete musician.

A concert pianist, collaborative pianist, vocal coach, and conductor, **Dr. Howard Kim** has been actively performing across the United States in both solo and chamber concerts. He has won numerous awards and honors both as a solo and collaborative pianist and has been a featured soloist with orchestras, most recently, with the Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra. He received his early piano training from master teacher Dorothy Hwang at the R.D. Colburn School of Performing Arts and his Bachelor of Arts in Piano Performance from the University of California-Los Angeles, studying under Antoinette Perry and Aube Tzerko. While completing the Master of Music and Doctor of Musical Arts degrees in Piano Performance and Literature under the tutelage of Rebecca Penneys at the Eastman School of Music, he was awarded the Performer's Certificate. Dr. Kim is currently Keyboardist for the Fayetteville Symphony Orchestra and the Fayetteville Jazz Orchestra, and Assistant Professor of Music at Fayetteville State University.
